

Dyckesville Dolphins Mission Statement

The goal of the Dyckesville Dolphins 4-H Club is to provide a quality learning experience for each individual member. To be successful, we encourage the participation of each family member to assist in the various community projects.

Expectations

- Requirement: to be eligible to show at the fair each member must attend four (4) club meetings.
- Requirement: Each member must participate in a minimum of two (2) club fundraisers per year.
- Requirement: Each member must meet all their individual project requirements to show at the fair.
- Requirement: to be eligible to show at the fair and to be in good standings with the club each member (not family) must participate in a minimum of two (2) community service options. One service being the club's yearly grounds clean up at St Louis Parish Hall and one from the other choices offered for the year.

BV-Laws

1. Open to any youth within grade parameter Kindergarten to the next 4-H year following their high school graduation, regardless of that person's race, color, creed, religion, sex, national origin, disability, ancestry, sexual orientation, pregnancy, marital or prenatal.
2. In the event of dissolution of the club any and all remaining funds and assets will be turned over to the Kewaunee County Adult Leaders Association.
3. Elections of officers shall take place at the first yearly meeting (September) and will include President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Sergeant at Arms, and any other positions deemed necessary by a majority vote of the club. Officers can be 4th grade or higher. If the officer missed 2 meetings unexcused, the member will not be able to run for office next year.

General Meetings will be held on the second Thursday of every month. The meetings are at 6:30 pm at the St. Louis Parish Hall in Dyckesville. Unless otherwise decided at monthly meetings of the month before.

Club members who fail to meet these criteria will NOT be able to show at the fair, any and all requirements must be met by the time fair forms are due or will not be submitted to Kewaunee County.
